We have now been in our new place of service for two months, and although our ministry has changed since we left Monterrey, our vision and passion remain the same: to see God’s glory proclaimed among the nations. We are so thankful to God for his leading in our lives. We see our new ministry as *To Every Tribe’s Mexico Field Director* and as the **assistant director** of the *Center for Pioneer Church Planting* as a unique opportunity to make God’s name glorious among the nations. Our time here has gone very well as we’ve settled in and begun our new responsibilities. Here are some highlights from the last couple of months:

- I’ve been privileged to take two mission trips into Mexico, visiting some of the villages that *To Every Tribe* works in. We’re very excited to be able to make regular trips into Mexico and to become involved in church planting in areas currently outside of the gospel’s reach.
- One of the most enjoyable aspects of our new ministry is the community here at the *Center for Pioneer Church Planting*. The CPCP is a major part of our ministry here at *To Every Tribe*.
